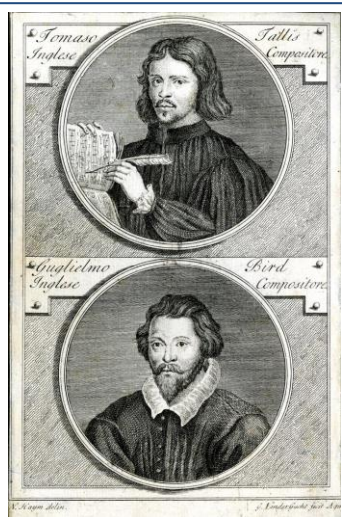

An Illustrated Talk by Patrick Craig

Patrick's career with The Tallis Scholars and The Cardinal's Musick has been dominated by the music of Tallis and Byrd. *Cantiones Sacrae*, the first ever volume of English printed music, contains some of their most glorious works. Dedicated to Queen Elizabeth, it offers a glimpse into the turbulent political times that both composers lived through.

Patrick received a beautiful new scholarly edition of this volume of 32 motets as his leaving present from the Tallis Scholars in 2016. He will explore both its treasures and the lives of the two men who created it.
