TVEMF's Christmas workshop on Monday 14th December will be a little different this year. We won't be getting together in Amersham to have our annual feast of music and food. Instead we'll have a Zoom meeting at 7pm and you'll have to supply your own refreshments (optional of course).

Join in with your renaissance instruments and voices, or just enjoy listening to Andrew Griffiths as he explores well-known renaissance Christmas music, focussing particularly on Hieronymus Praetorius's Magnificat Quinti Toni, famous for the carols (In dulci jubilo and Josef Lieber) interpolated between the verses. He'll be looking at the historical background, context, sources and other interesting features before he leads us in a (muted) rehearsal and performance. Pitch will be A=440 and PDFs will be supplied for you to print out in advance.
